



Consider Five Strategies



BUILD BACK SMARTER

Acknowledge learners' losses while affirming learning ability. Optimize learning environments while prioritizing reconnection.



BUILD BACK BROADER

Support complementary learning delivery systems and modalities. Invest in program-level staff and city-level coordinating structures.



BUILD BACK BOLDER

Focus on how, why, and with whom learning happens. Respect and diversify learners' experiences and contexts and adults' expertise and power.



BUILD OUT INEQUITY DATA

Equity is the goal, but inequity is the reality.

Acknowledging skepticism, take time to get baseline data right in order to truly cover all bases.




BUILD ON ADOLESCENTS' DETERMINATION
