

Youth Program Quality Intervention (YPQI)

ASSESS

Observe programming. Collect data about your program.

PLAN

Use the data to create an improvement **plan** with your team.

IMPROVE


Carry out your plan. **Train** & **coach** staff.





Assess

- The PQA allows you to observe what actually goes on in your youth programs.
- Assessment is a team effort.
- The focus is on improvement and support, not evaluation.

Planning the Data Collection

- Things to Keep in Mind:
 - Each person should try to observe at least 20 minutes of programming.
 - Focus on your "program offerings" or structured, regular activities.

Scoring Meeting

- Things to Keep in Mind:
 - Score PQA together as a team
 - This conversation is what really starts the improvement process.
- How did your meeting go OR what questions do you still have?







Entering Your Data

- Scores Reporter allows you to enter your PQA Data and create reports.
- Accounts are created at the site level.
- Each site has been assigned a unique 8 digit number. That number will be entered as the username when accessing the CYPQ Online Portal.


